The Roland Township ZONING BOARD was called to order at 7:05 p.m. December 9, 2019, in the Quilt Inn Meeting Room by Chairman Vern Jacobson with Supervisors Mike Hall, David Thompson and Michael Sivertson in attendance, also Zoning Administrator Tim Kihle and Clerk Glenore Gross. Treasurers Report was presented, with Cash/Fund balance of \$451,916.06 and request to pay bills of \$29,841.46. Revenue on hand to deposit is \$3,307.35 as an upfront special assessment payment with interest. Clerk noted a payment of \$100,000 of accumulated specials payments should be sent to the Bond fund *MOTION by David T to approve the Treasurers report as presented and approve all payments; 2nd by Michael S. VOTE-4 YES = CARRIED.* The Cabin Road Paving Project Bond loan at \$1,624,563.92 and Security First checking funds of \$39,892.86 were included in the report.

ZONING ADMINISTRATOR REPORT:

Tim had no new permits at this time. The following was addressed:

Parking Plan for Lake House – Donnet Sivertson/Twin Oaks area: With the Twin Oaks parking lot not available for her proposed new business, Sivertson plans to purchase the lots north of the Lake House building to use for parking, after clearing and adding gravel. Since they are zoned RE-1, discussion was held on whether they would need to be zoned Commercial; it isn't directly addressed in the zoning ordinance. Board suggested a rezone should be considered. It was also noted that purchase of the Lake House property is still in process.

He understood it had been donated to the township and asked if the township would vacate it. He said the county reported that no one pays taxes on it. Ownership and a potential road vacation will be investigated.
